Login to your profile

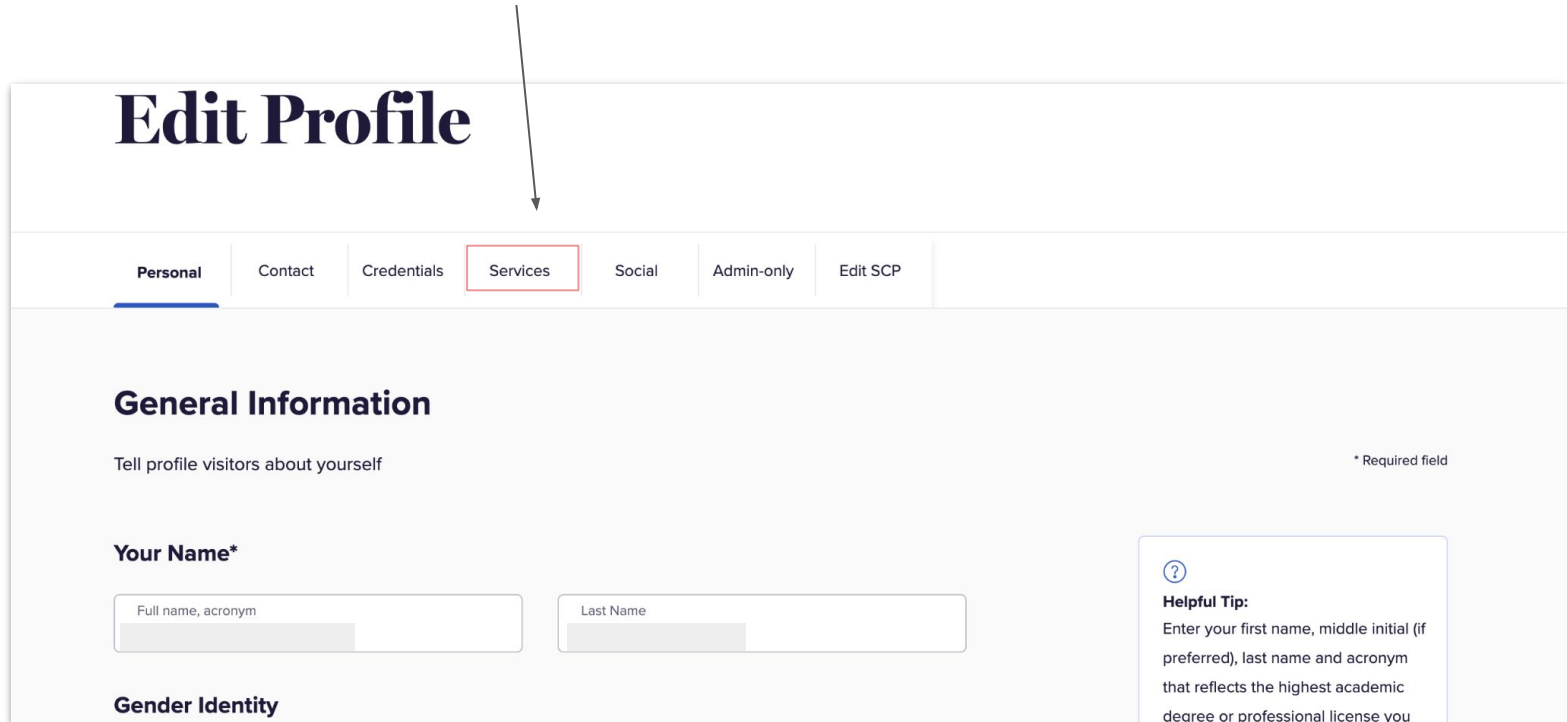
STEP 2:
